

DECRETO Nº 012, de 04 de maio de 2020.

Ementa: Estabelece em regime especial as atividades escolares na forma de aulas não presenciais, em decorrência da pandemia causada pelo COVID-19.

O Prefeito do Município de Sirinhaém, fazendo uso regular das suas atribuições legais, autorizado pelo art. 72, inciso IV, da Lei Orgânica do Município,

DECRETA:

Art. 1.º. Estabelece no âmbito da Secretaria Municipal de Educação, em caráter excepcional, o regime especial para a oferta de atividades escolares na forma de aulas não presenciais, em conformidade com o disposto na MP 934/2020 e do Parecer do CNE/CP nº 5, de 28 de abril de 2020, exaradas em decorrência da pandemia causada pelo COVID-19.

Parágrafo único. O regime especial previsto no caput deste artigo tem início a partir de 18 de maio de 2020 e será automaticamente finalizado por meio de ato do Governador do Estado de Pernambuco que determine o encerramento do período de suspensão das aulas presenciais ou por expressa manifestação do Conselho Estadual de Educação de Pernambuco.

Art. 2.º. Fica sob a responsabilidade da Secretaria Municipal de Educação a oferta das atividades não presenciais para o Ensino Fundamental Anos Iniciais e Anos Finais, Educação infantil (Creche e pré- escola) e EJAI na rede pública de Sirinhaém.

Art. 3.º. As atividades escolares não presenciais são aquelas utilizadas pelo professor sendo ele da turma ou do componente curricular destinadas à interação com o estudante por meio de aulas on-line síncronas e aulas assíncronas por meio de orientações impressas, estudos dirigidos, quizzes, plataformas virtuais, correio eletrônico, chats, fóruns, diário eletrônico, videoaulas, audiochamadas, videochamadas, materiais impressos compatíveis com a idade dos alunos para a realização (leitura, desenhos, pintura, recorte, dobradura, colagem, entre outros); utilização de mídias sociais de longo alcance (*WhatsApp, Facebook, Instagram* etc.)

Art.4º. As formações continuadas dos professores, técnicos, auxiliares de serviços educacionais, auxiliares de creche, coordenadores e gestores serão realizadas de forma remota semanalmente por meio de plataformas virtuais e a utilização de mídias sociais de longo alcance (*WhatsApp, Facebook, Instagram* etc.)

Art. 5º. A Secretaria Municipal de Educação de Sirinhaém, a qualquer tempo, poderá expedir Instruções Normativas Complementares para garantir a efetividade da implantação do regime especial neste ato disciplinado.

Art. 6º. Este decreto entra em vigor na data de sua publicação, ficando revogadas as disposições em contrário.
